Join us during this 9-day period for the opportunity to immerse yourself in 9 days of intense raft & safety kayak assessments. Based on the Stunning Piva & Tara-Drina rivers in Bosnia & Montenegro. We will be based at the camp of Tara raft on the shores of the Drina river where full board & Accommodation will be available.

The course will be divided into 3 sections

Section 1: Rescue 3 Europe Whitewater Rescue Technician Professional (WRT-PRO)

- Dates: 22nd,23rd ,24th March 2018.
- 3 days of intense internationally recognised Whitewater rescue for river professionals.

- Cost: Non-residential €260 per person. Residential €320 (3 nights full board & Accommodation)



Section 2: International Rafting Federation Guide, safety kayaker & trip leader workshop.

- Trip leader.
- Safety kayaker
- IRF Admin fees not included.
- Cost: Non-residential €310. Residential €390 (4 nights Full board & Accommodation).

Section 3: International Rafting Federation Instructor assessment workshop.

- Dates 25th,26th,27,28th,29th,30th March 2018.
- All students wishing to be tested for an IRF Instructor award must have their personal skills tested. Full attendance of section 2 is compulsory.
- All instructor students must pre-register and provide evidence that they meet in course pre- requisites (see below).
- IRF admin fees not included.
- Cost: Non-residential €500. Residential €620 (6 nights full board & Accommodation) The fee includes participation in section 2.



Pre-requisites:

Each candidate must provide his or her own cold weather Personal protective equipment. (PPE)

- Helmet
- White water Personal floatation device (PFD)
- River Footwear
- Full 5mm wetsuit or drysuit
- Personal rescue equipment

For all students wishing to take pass an IRF award you must provide the following Prior to commencement of the course.

- Evidence of a valid in date Minimum 8hr first aid certificate for raft guides & safety kayakers.
- Evidence of an advanced first aid certificate for instructors & Trip leaders.
- Full experience up to date logbook.
