IRF Raft instructor (trainer) must have a high level of Trip-Leader skill and knowledge; also must have a current advanced first aid certificate, log Book and private accident insurance certificate.

IRF Instructor must have high level of skill and experience in training and assessing Guides and Trip-Leaders. HE/She must be physically capable of demonstrating all Raft Guide skills.

Minimum whitewater experience required:

for IRF Instructor cl.3: 100 runs or 200 hours as TL cl.3 or above

for IRF Instructor cl.4/5 100 runs or 200 hours as TL cl. 4/5 or above
