Dondy Raharjo by his friends called Djadjo. In Pre World Rafting Championship is responsible for route setting for Slalom, Sprint and Head to Head start as well as finish. His job is quite a big responsibility because his course will be a spectator attraction. With out a catchy course the crowd will not come.

That's not all. If his course is not up to par for the international athletesthey will be disappointed. After all they came from thousands of kilometers to test their strength and agility at this event.

For Djadjo this event is his ultimate work during his carrer as a route setter for river running. "Before it was for national championship, and the highest was the AustralAsia Championship back in 2010."

But working in Citarik river is easier for Djadjo as the river is not to wide and there are a lot of trees to tie the gate wires. Compared to Serayu river in Central Java where AustralAsia Championship was held, which is 200meter wide.

Other challenges are the remoteness of the competition venue. Djadjo has to bring all his equipment from the capital Jakarta. If he miss calculated it will be a long way to get extra wire, plier or whats not.

Djadjo main goal is to make rafting main stream sport in Indonesia. The father of one daughter whom has graduated university feels that Indonesia rafting needs a second generation of course setter. That is his next ultimate goal.

## **Boat Requirement**

International Rafting Federation, had issued the latest competition rules in June 2014. Most of the National Judges in Indonesia is not yet familiar with the changes from the former rules. Hence the Judge Workshop.

Indonesia as the host of World Rafting Championship 2015 will provide the raft for all competitor. The initial plan is to use local brand, Boogie which was inspected by IRF accessor, Willie Joe Jones whom now is IRF President.

Here is the boat specific requirement for R6 Minimum length 425cm (14ft); Minimum width 200cm, Thwarts 3, Foot cones 6-8; Minimum tube diameter 50cm, Minimum weight 50kg
