The elite team from Indonesia has a long history rivalry. On all the three rafting discipline their closely tied. On the second day the difference is only 5second with DKI ahead. Total Slalom time for DKI was 5 minute 3second, while West Jawa was 5 minute 08 second.

In third place was Central Jawa with total time of 5minute 16second.
