Any instructor candidates that pass the instructor assessment will become provisional instructors. This means they must run a designated number of workshops whilst been observed by an IRF assessor before they can be granted full instructor status

Conditions of admission: Advanced First Aid with CPR not older than 2 years. Log book as proof of experience before assessment.
Personnal insurance covering raft accident.

Raft Instructor must have a high level of Trip-Leader skills and experience. Must be physically capable of demonstrating all Raft Guide skills..

Safety Kayakers; highly manoeuvrable whitewater kayaking providing safety and swimmer rescue on commercial whitewater trips, operated by professionals. (inflatable or hardshell canoes and kayaks, oar rafts, catarafts, sledges, river boards, hydrospeed, etc...)

Safety Kayaker must have the skills and knowledge to be a competent Safety Crafter on commercial whitewater trips and operate as a member of the guide crew, knowing standard whitewater rescue techniques as well as have a current standard first aid certificate.

Safety Kayak Instructor (trainer) must have a high level of Safety Kayaker skills and knowledge; also must have an advanced First aid certificate. Safety Kayak Instructor must have high level of skills and experience in training and assessing safety crafters. He/She must be physically capable of demonstrating all Safety Kayaker skills.

Students need to attend the course fully prepared with the correct personal protective equipment (PPE) & personal rescue equipment (PRE) needed to operate as a guide.

Once the certifications have been passed the additional IRF certification fees will need to be paid to the IRF:
