

Evidence required for rafting competitors representing a nation they are not a citizen of Category A and B (World and Continental level) events

Requirement for proof of domicile:

If a competitor does not possess a passport or official permanent residency documentation from the country that they are representing, they must provide proof to IRF Admin that they are permanently domiciled in the country. This proof must be in the form of TWO (2) documents in their name (OR their parent's name for U19 competitors). A copy of the competitor's passport is also required. This evidence will be presented to the Sport & Competition Committee for review and approval, in line with the currently published Race Rules.

Acceptable proofs of Permanent Residency: (not two of the same)

- Lease or Mortgage documents from the Resident Country
- Voter's registration documents from the Resident Country
- Tax returns giving the Resident Country as the home address
- Paycheck stub OR letter of employment verification in the Resident Country on company letterhead (signed by a manager of the personnel department)
- Driver's License OR National ID OR Student ID card from the Resident Country (all ID cards count as one proof)
- Resident Country Bank account checking or savings statements (with acceptable dates)
- Marriage license or divorce decree issued in the Resident Country
- License or certificate issued by the Resident Country (with issue & expiration dates)
- Resident Country utility bill (DWP, gas, telephone, cable all utility bills count as one proof)
- Resident Country State Aid or Social Welfare
- Car registration and/or car insurance in Resident Country
- Health insurance OR Medical ID from Resident Country

If the competitor has raced for another nation within the last two years, a letter from that federation also needs to be submitted stating that they release the competitor.
