The Kazakhstan Rafting Federation invites all Rafting Teams for the IRF R4 Open Asian Rafting Championship in Republic of Kazakhstan.

Races will be held on river Koksu – Taldykorgan region in **R4 Open men** and **R4 Open women** category, in all discipline (Sprint, H2H, Slalom and Downriver) according to IRF Race rules. Category **Youth, Junior and Master** will also be held if at least three teams per category are registered.

Registration date: Registration closing date is 10 May 2023. All teams must to register until May 10 to Maxim Zimin by e-mail rafting@rafting.kz

Entry fee: €120 (EUR) per person. Deadline for Entry Fee payments is 15 May 2023. No late payments accepted.

Accommodation in tent camp, food and transport to and from the venue on Koksu river are included in entry fee. Transport from the camp on Koksu river to downriver start position is included in entry fee.

Race rules: Racing will be in accordance with IRF Race Rules: www.internationalrafting.com/racing/race-rules

Rafts: Official rafts supplied are Time Trial

Equipment: Teams are responsible for their own PFD, paddles, helmets, footwear, paddling clothing, throw bags and any additional paddling accessories they might require. We recommend a 3mm neoprene wetsuit for competitors.

Accommodation: From 13 till 19 June 2023, accommodation in tent camp will be provided as base option (including in Entry Fee). For those who want another options like rooms or guest houses must contact individually rafting@rafting.kz

Meals: From 13 till 19 June 2023, all meals will be provided (including in Entry Fee). If you have any dietary requirements, please contact us in advance.

Awards: The Organiser will provide the medals for the winning teams.
